

MASTER'S CUP

Genesee Valley Hunt subscribers' horses become eligible for the Master's Cup by completing the G.V.H. Horse Trials and compile points as explained below. Please contact the Hunt Secretary if you would like your horse considered for the Master's Cup. If there are too many entries, finalists will be selected to compete in the Master's Test based on qualifying scores.

HORSE TRIALS	(total points possible)
Foxhunters	200 points
Pre-novice	200 points
Novice	400 points
Training	500 points
Preliminary	600 points
Intermediate	700 points

To get correct Horse Trials scores, add the total penalties from all three phases and then subtract them from the total points possible listed above. Horse Trials scores will be rounded to nearest whole number. Fractions will only be used to break a tie.

RACING OVER FENCES	Steeplechase	Paced Race
First place	100 points	80 points
Second place	90 points	70 points
Third place	80 points	60 points
Finish with rider	50 points	30 points

The two best finishes from the current seasons races will be used for the steeplechase race points. Steeplechase "pace races" may be permitted at the point scale shown above. Then add the finish from the point-to-Point.

HUNTING

30 points per hunt at which the horse was present from the start of meet until the end of the meet.

15 points per hunt at which the horse hunted, but did not stay out until the end of the meet.

Hunting dates must be listed by the owner of the horse and presented to the secretary.

Maximum of 500 points total

HUNTER PACE – points will be distributed as follows for the Genesee Valley Hunt Hunter Pace in the Fast Time or Optimum (Ideal) Divisions only

First place	50 points
Second place	40 points
Successful finish	30 points

SPECIAL TEST

Designed by the Masters to test the training and obedience of the ideal hunt horse. Professional riders who ride horses in races or the Horse Trials may not amass points for the Master's Cup. This will be left to the discretion of the Master's on an individual basis.
